Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 1 Percent from Last Year

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.31 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending March 25, 2023, up 1 percent from the comparable week in 2022 and up slightly from the previous week.

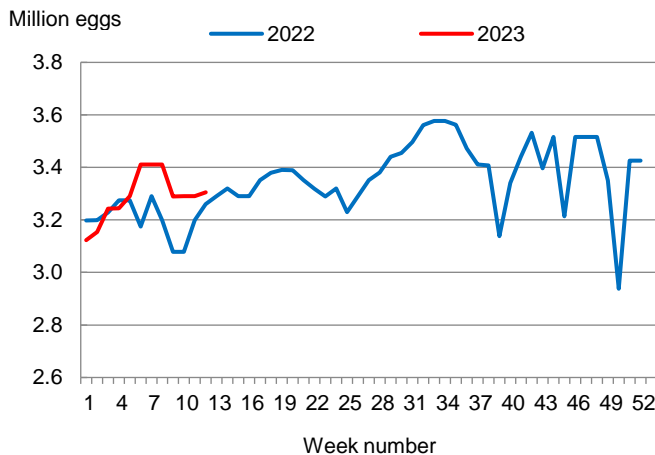
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 242 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 25, 2023, up 1 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 12 Percent

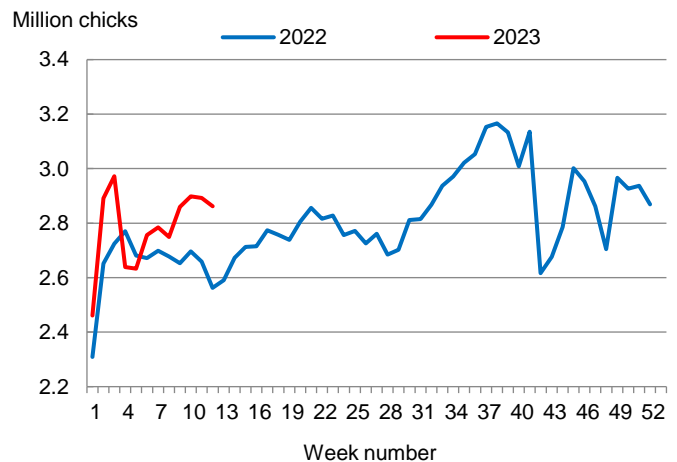
Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.86 million chicks during the week ending March 25, 2023, up 12 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but down 1 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending March 25, 2023, down slightly from a year ago.
