Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 5 Percent from Last Year

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.50 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending July 8, 2023, up 5 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but unchanged from the previous week.

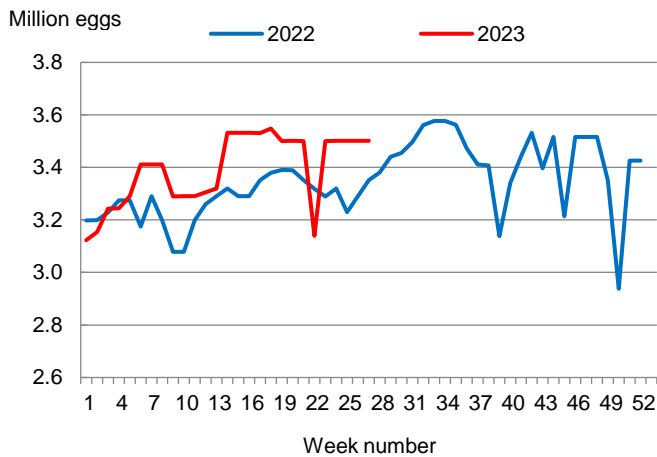
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 242 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 8, 2023, down 1 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 1 Percent

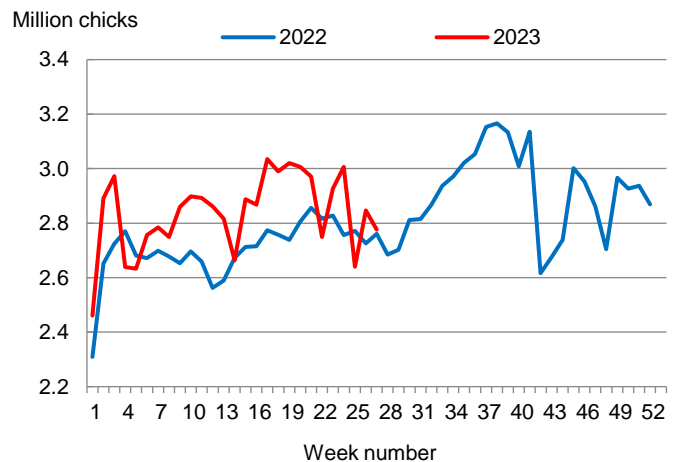
Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.78 million chicks during the week ending July 8, 2023, up 1 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but down 2 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 188 million chicks for meat production during the week ending July 8, 2023, down 1 percent from a year ago.
