Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 12 Percent from Last Year

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.59 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending November 11, 2023, up 12 percent from the comparable week in 2022 and up 23 percent from the previous week.

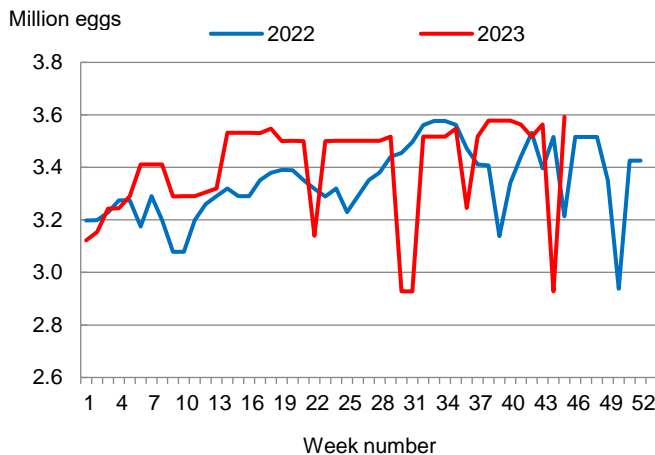
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 230 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 11, 2023, down 3 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Down 21 Percent

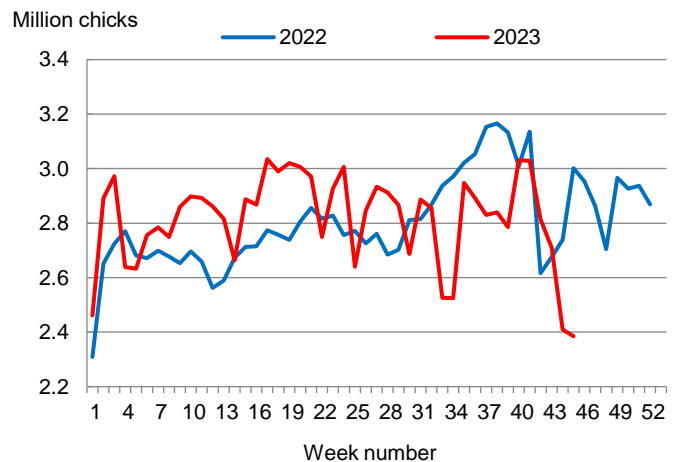
Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.39 million chicks during the week ending November 11, 2023, down 21 percent from the comparable week in 2022 and down 1 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 177 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 11, 2023, down 4 percent from a year ago.
