According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 28, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 12 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 4 percent short, 93 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 19 percent short, 54 percent adequate, and 23 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 11 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 33 percent surplus.
