## Michigan Floriculture Sales Worth More Than \$695 Million

Michigan floriculture was worth more than \$695 million in 2023, according to Marlo D. Johnson, Regional Director, USDA NASS, Great Lakes Region.

Michigan floriculture producers sold \$695 million worth of floriculture commodities in 2023. This was down 2 percent from the \$711 million sold in 2022.

There was 51.8 million square feet of greenhouse used to produce floriculture crops in 2023, up slightly from 2022.

Six hundred eighty-one producers in Michigan sold at least \$10,000 worth of floriculture products last year, up from 514 the previous year. The smallest sales classes accounted for most of the increase in producers.
