



Minnesota Ag News – Vegetables Annual Summary

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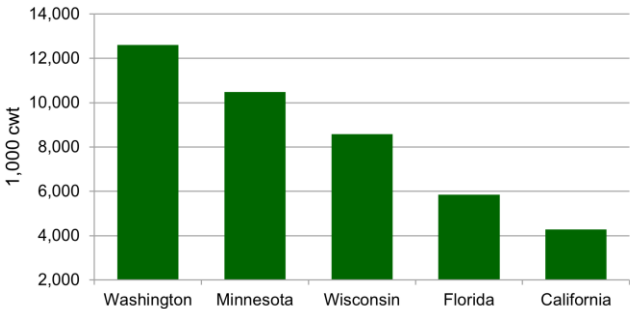
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In 2024 there were 80,700 acres of **sweet corn** harvested in Minnesota with a total production of 10.5 million cwt, according to the USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Vegetables 2024 Summary*. Utilized production was valued at \$57.9 million. Minnesota ranked second for sweet corn production with 20 percent of the nation's production. U.S. sweet corn production totaled 52.7 million cwt.

Green pea production in Minnesota in 2024 totaled 869,900 cwt from 27,100 harvested acres. The value of green pea production totaled \$17.0 million. Minnesota ranked second for green pea production with 19 percent of the nation's production. Pea production in the U.S. totaled 4.50 million cwt.
