**Week Ending: June 7, 2020**

**Released: June 8, 2020**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 7, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 15 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 17 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 61.4 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 70.9 degrees at Columbia. Highs ranged from 83.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi to 91.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Cleveland. Light to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the coastal part of the State with an average of 4.78 inches.
