## Mississippi Crop Progress and Condition

**Delta Region - Mississippi Field Office**

**Week Ending: May 30, 2021**

**Released: June 1, 2021**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, May 30, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 20 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 13 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 57.2 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 70.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Saucier. Highs ranged from 82.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 91.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Laurel. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the upper delta part of the State with an average of 0.95 inch.
