Week Ending: June 20, 2021

Released: June 21, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 4.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 20, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 2 percent short, 71 percent adequate, and 27 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 61.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 73.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi. Highs ranged from 86.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi to 94.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Belzoni. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the coastal part of the State with an average of 5.98 inches.
