According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 14, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 16 percent very short, 32 percent short, 50 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 17 percent very short, 39 percent short, 42 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
