Corn Yield and Production Up from August Cotton Yield and Production Unchanged from August Rice Yield and Production Unchanged from August Soybean Yield and Production Unchanged from August

Mississippi **corn** for grain production is forecast at 90.3 million bushels, up 2 percent from August 1 forecast but down 35 percent from 2023. Based on conditions as of September 1, yield is expected to average 190 bushels per acre, up 4 bushels from last month and up 9 bushels from last year. Harvested acreage for grain is estimated at 475,000 acres, down 295,000 acres from 2023.

**Upland cotton** production is forecast at 1.20 million bales, unchanged from the August 1 forecast but 309,000 bales above last year. Based on conditions as of September 1, yield is expected to average 1,118 pounds per harvested acre, unchanged from last month but up 35 pounds from 2023. Harvested acreage is estimated at 515,000 acres, up 120,000 acres from 2023.

**Peanut** production in 2024 is forecast at 95.0 million pounds, unchanged from the August 1 forecast but up 65 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of September 1, yield is expected to average 3,800 pounds per acre, unchanged from last month but up 200 pounds from last year. Area for harvest, at 25,000 acres, is up 9,000 acres from 2023

All rice production for the state is forecast at 11.7 million hundredweight, unchanged from the August 1 forecast but up 31 percent from last year's production of 8.96 million hundredweight. Based on conditions as of September 1, the all rice yield for 2024 is forecast at 7,500 pounds per acre, unchanged from last month but up 30 pounds from last year. Producers expect to harvest 156,000 acres of rice, up 36,000 acres from 2023.

**Soybean** production in 2024 is forecast at 132 million bushels, unchanged from the August 1 forecast but up 10 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of September 1, yield is expected to average 58 bushels per acre, unchanged from last month but up 2 bushels from last year. Harvested acreage estimated at 2.27 million acres, up 140,000 acres from 2023.
