July 1 All Foodsize Inventory Down 2 Percent

Commercial catfish operations in Mississippi had 69.0 million foodsize fish on hand on July 1, 2024. The breakouts of foodsize fish inventory numbers on July 1, 2024, with their respective percent change from the previous year were: large foodsize at 1.53 million fish, down 12 percent; medium foodsize at 26.6 million fish, down 1 percent; and small foodsize at 40.9 million fish, down 2 percent.

Mississippi was ranked first in the nation, ahead of Arkansas and Alabama, in total foodsize catfish inventory on July 1, 2024. Total stockers, at 121 million fish, were down 27 percent from a year ago.



Definitions Used for Catfish Production


• Broodfish: Fish kept for egg production, including males, 3 to 10 lbs., or 4 to 6 years of age.

- Large foodsize: Over 3 lbs. per fish.
- Medium foodsize: 1 ½ to 3 lbs. per fish.
- Small foodsize: ³/₄ to 1 ¹/₂ lbs. per fish.

• Large stockers: 180 to 750 lbs. per 1,000 fish. • Fingerlings: 2 to 60 lbs. per 1,000 fish or 2" to 6" in length.







• Small stockers: 60 to 180 lbs. per 1,000 fish or over 6" in length.

Mississippi Water Surface Area Set at 29,900 Acres

The water surface area to be used for catfish production in Mississippi during July 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, totaled 29,900 acres. During July 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, water surface acres intended for foodsize catfish production is expected to total 23,000 acres. A total of 1,800 acres were taken out of production during the January 1, 2024 through June 30, 2024 period.
