Foodsize Catfish Sales Down 26 Percent from 2023

Mississippi catfish producers had 74.1 million foodsize fish on January 1, 2025, down 12 percent from a year ago. The number of large foodsize inventory on hand totaled 1.18 million fish, down 14 percent from January 1, 2024. Medium foodsize inventory, at 27.2 million fish, was down 19 percent from last year; while, small foodsize inventory at 45.7 million fish, was down 7 percent from January 1, 2024. Mississippi catfish growers had foodsize fish sales of \$185 million during 2024, down 26 percent from 2023.

Definitions Used for Catfish Production


 Broodfish: Fish kept for egg production, including males, 3 to 2 	10 lbs., or 4 to 6 years of age.
 Large foodsize: Over 3 lbs. per fish. 	 Large stockers: 180 to 750 lbs. per 1,000 fish.

• Medium foodsize: 1 1/2 to 3 lbs. per fish.

• Small foodsize: 3/4 to 1 1/2 lbs. per fish.

• Small stockers: 60 to 180 lbs. per 1,000 fish or over 6" in length.

• Fingerlings: 2 to 60 lbs. per 1,000 fish or 2" to 6" in length.
