Special Note:

Cattle program changes were made following the 2022 Census of Agriculture. As a result of these changes, a reduced number of data items are published for the following states beginning in January 2025: AK, CT, DE, HI, IN, LA, ME, MD, MA, MS, NV, NH, NJ, NC, RI, SC, UT, VT, and WV. Estimates of all cattle and calves inventory, all cows inventory, and calf crop are still published for all states.

Mississippi January 1 All Cattle Inventory Unchanged

All cattle and calves in Mississippi as of January 1, 2025, totaled 810,000 head, were unchanged from January 1, 2024. The calf crop for the full year of 2024 was 345,000 head, unchanged from last year. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 430,000 head, were unchanged from January 1, 2024.

Meat and other goat inventory in Mississippi, on January 1, 2025, totaled 19,000 head, down 10 percent from the previous year.


