



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 28, 2024

**Corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 191 million bushels, up 40 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 135 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 56.4 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 98.5 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 55.2 million bushels, down 11 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 30.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 25.2 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 53.2 million bushels.

**Old crop all wheat** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 10.2 million bushels, up 15 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 420,000 bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 9.76 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 9.86 million bushels.
