

Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 28, 2024

Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 191 million bushels, up 40 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 135 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 56.4 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 98.5 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 55.2 million bushels, down 11 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 30.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 25.2 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 53.2 million bushels.

Old crop all wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 10.2 million bushels, up 15 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 420,000 bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 9.76 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 9.86 million bushels.
