Winter Wheat: Harvested area in 2024 is forecast at 520,000 acres, down 13 percent from last year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 70 bushels per acre, equal to 2023. Production is forecast at 36.4 million bushels, down 13 percent from the previous year.
