



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released September 30, 2024

**Old crop corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2024 totaled 68.1 million bushels, up 8 percent from September 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 33.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 35.1 million bushels. The June - August 2024 indicated disappearance is 123 million bushels.

**Old crop soybean** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2024 totaled 23.6 million bushels, up 9 percent from September 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 13.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 10.6 million bushels. The June - August 2024 indicated disappearance is 31.6 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2024 totaled 35.3 million bushels, down 15 percent from September 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 8.50 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 26.8 million bushels. The June - August 2024 indicated disappearance is 10.8 million bushels.
