

Missouri Small Grains 2024 Summary

Released September 30, 2024

Winter wheat: Planted area in 2024 is estimated at 670,000 acres, down 14 percent from 2023. Harvested area, estimated at 480,000 acres, is down 20 percent from last year. The winter wheat yield is estimated at 75 bushels per acre, up 5 bushels from 2023. Production is estimated at 36.0 million bushels, down 14 percent from the previous year.
