



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released January 10, 2025

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2024 totaled 426 million bushels, up 4 percent from December 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 310 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 116 million bushels. The September - November 2024 indicated disappearance is 246 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2024 totaled 178 million bushels, up slightly from December 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 120 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 58.0 million bushels. The September - November 2024 indicated disappearance is 132 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2024 totaled 26.0 million bushels, down 18 percent from December 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 4.00 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 22.0 million bushels. The September - November 2024 indicated disappearance is 9.28 million bushels.
