## NEBRASKA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**LINCOLN, Neb. February 3, 2025** - For the week ending February 2, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 27% very short, 51% short, 22% adequate, and 0% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 30% very short, 47% short, 23% adequate, and 0% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 9% very poor, 25% poor, 41% fair, 25% good, and 0% excellent.

The next report will be issued March 3, 2025.
