NEBRASKA CHICKENS AND EGGS

LINCOLN, Neb. February 25, 2022 - All layers in Nebraska during January 2022 totaled 8.40 million, up from 8.20 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during January totaled 210 million eggs, up from 204 million in 2021. January egg production per 100 layers was 2,497 eggs, compared to 2,482 eggs in 2021.
