NEBRASKA CHICKENS AND EGGS

LINCOLN, Neb. August 22, 2022 - All layers in Nebraska during July 2022 totaled 5.45 million, down from 8.19 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during July totaled 128 million eggs, down from 201 million in 2021. July egg production per 100 layers was 2,350 eggs, compared to 2,448 eggs in 2021.
