NEBRASKA CHICKENS AND EGGS

LINCOLN, Neb. June 24, 2024 - All layers in Nebraska during May 2024 totaled 8.50 million, up from 7.90 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during May totaled 216 million eggs, up from 196 million in 2023. May egg production per 100 layers was 2,540 eggs, compared to 2,475 eggs in 2023.
