## NEBRASKA CHICKENS AND EGGS

**LINCOLN, Neb. February 24, 2025** - All layers in Nebraska during January 2025 totaled 8.74 million, up from 8.30 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during January totaled 221 million eggs, up from 210 million in 2024. January egg production per 100 layers was 2,526 eggs, compared to 2,528 eggs in 2024.
