January Milk Production in California down 1.9 percent

Milk production during January totaled 3.535 billion pounds, down 1.9 percent from January 2021 and up 1.3 percent December 2021. The number of milk cows on farms in California was 1.72 million head, unchanged from January 2021 and up 1,000 from December 2021. Production per cow in California averaged 2,055 pounds, down 40 pounds from January 2021 and up 25 pounds from December 2021.


