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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 9, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 17 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 27 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 14 percent short, 61 percent adequate, and 24 percent surplus.
