According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 16, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 7 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 12 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus.
