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Week ending June 23, 2024

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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 23, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 13 percent short, 44 percent adequate, and 36 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 16 percent short, 46 percent adequate, and 34 percent surplus.
