According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 7, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 6 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 22 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 4 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 39 percent surplus.
