Milk production in **New York** during December 2024 totaled 1.35 billion pounds, up 0.7 percent from December 2023. The average milk price received by New York farmers in November 2024, at \$25.30 per hundredweight, is \$0.30 lower than October 2024 but \$1.70 higher than November a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during December 2024 totaled 821 million pounds, unchanged from December 2023. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in November 2024, at \$25.00 per hundredweight, is \$0.40 lower than October 2024 but \$1.80 higher than November a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during December 2024 totaled 208 million pounds, down 0.5 percent from December 2023. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in November 2024, at \$25.50 per hundredweight, is \$0.30 lower than October 2024 but \$1.90 higher than November a year ago.
