Milk production in **New York** during January 2025 totaled 1.36 billion pounds, up 2.0 percent from January 2024. The average milk price received by New York farmers in December 2024, at \$24.40 per hundredweight, is \$0.90 lower than November 2024 but \$2.20 higher than December a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during January 2025 totaled 842 million pounds, up 0.8 percent from January 2024. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in December 2024, at \$24.20 per hundredweight, is \$0.80 lower than November 2024 but \$2.60 higher than December a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during January 2025 totaled 211 million pounds, unchanged from January 2024. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in December 2024, at \$24.60 per hundredweight, is \$0.90 lower than November 2024 but \$2.20 higher than December a year ago.
