

Weather 2006 continued

November - Temperatures averaged much above normal with extremes of 78 degrees F at Moorestown on the 11th and 21 degrees F at Hightstown on the 4th. Precipitation totals were much above average, ranging from 8.09 inches at Atlantic City on 3.07 inches at Brant Beach. The greatest 24-hour rainfall was 4.74 inches on the 8th at Harrison.

December - Temperatures averaged much, much above normal with extremes ranging from 73 degrees F at Moorestown on the 2nd to 13 degrees F at Charlotteburg on the 8th. Precipitation totals were below normal ranging from 2.76 inches at Pottersville to 1.35 inches at Brant Beach. The greatest monthly snowfall was 0.1 inches at Sussex.
