## Weather 2006 continued

November - Temperatures averaged much above normal with extremes of 78 degrees $F$ at Moorestown on the $11^{\text {th }}$ and 21 degrees $F$ at Hightstown on the $4^{\text {th }}$. Precipitation totals were much above average, ranging from 8.09 inches at Atlantic City on 3.07 inches at Brant Beach. The greatest 24 -hour rainfall was 4.74 inches on the $8^{\text {th }}$ at Harrison.

December - Temperatures averaged much, much above normal with extremes ranging from 73 degrees $F$ at Moorestown on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ to 13 degrees $F$ at Charlotteburg on the $8^{\text {th }}$. Precipitation totals were below normal ranging from 2.76 inches at Pottersville to 1.35 inches at Brant Beach. The greatest monthly snowfall was 0.1 inches at Sussex.
