According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; May 3rd, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 78 percent adequate, and 22 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 75 percent adequate, and 25 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 100 percent good.
