According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 28, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 14 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 9 percent short, 84 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus.
