According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 19, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent short, 90 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 93 percent adequate and 7 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 4 percent fair, 47 percent good, and 49 percent excellent.
