According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 26, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 34 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 42 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 2 percent poor, 8 percent fair, 72 percent good, and 18 percent excellent.
