According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 1, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 16 percent short and 81 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent short and 93 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 1 percent poor, 30 percent fair and 69 percent good.
