According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 29, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 50 percent short, 35 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 42 percent very short, 22 percent short, 33 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 10 percent very poor, 30 percent poor, 35 percent fair, 23 percent good, and 2 percent excellent.
