## USDA announces 2022 Census of Agriculture data release details, preliminary return rate, and upcoming special studies

**TRENTON, NJ** – The United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) will release the 2022 Census of Agriculture data on February 13, 2024. NASS concluded the data collection this summer with a preliminary national return rate of 61%. The preliminary return rate in New Jersey is 59% with over 10,000 returned forms. The ag census, conducted once every five years, was mailed to more than 17,000 producers across New Jersey late last year. NASS plans to release the data from the 2022 Puerto Rico Census of Agriculture in summer 2024. Early next year, NASS will conduct the Census of Agriculture in the U.S. territories of American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, and U.S. Virgin Islands.

"Thank you to the farmers and ranchers in New Jersey who responded," said NASS New Jersey State Statistician Bruce Eklund. "The data collected in the Ag Census provides a picture of the current state of agriculture and rural America and is used to make decisions that impact our farmers, ranchers, communities, and businesses. The data cover categories that are important to the agricultural industry, and make it possible to compare national, state, and county level statistics."

The ag census data will be available at <a href="nass.usda.gov/AgCensus">nass.usda.gov/AgCensus</a> and in NASS's searchable database, <a href="Quick Stats">Quick Stats</a>. Publication dates for the various ag census data products can be found on NASS's online <a href="2024">2024</a> <a href="Agricultural Statistics Board Calendar">Agricultural Statistics Board Calendar</a>. Like all NASS data, ag census data will be available in aggregate form only, ensuring that no individual operation or producer can be identified, as required by federal law.

In addition to the U.S. territory ag census data collection, two ag census special studies that will provide more in-depth information on certain industries will be conducted this fall and winter: the 2023 <a href="Census of Aquaculture">Census of Aquaculture</a> and the 2023 <a href="Irrigation and Water Management Survey">Irrigation and Water Management Survey</a>. These questionnaires will be mailed to the producers who reported these activities in the 2022 Census of Agriculture.
