New Jersey annual crop production

TRENTON, NJ --- Corn for grain production is estimated at 9.58 million bushels, according to Bruce Eklund, state Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New Jersey Field Office. The average yield in New Jersey was estimated at 157.0 bushels per acre. Area harvested for grain is estimated at 61 thousand acres.

Corn silage production is estimated at 85 thousand tons. Silage yield is estimated at 17.0 tons per acre. Area harvested for silage is estimated at 5 thousand acres.

Soybean production is estimated at 4.43 million bushels. Yield is estimated at 43.0 bushels per acre. Harvested area is 103 thousand acres.

Other hay production is estimated at 149 thousand tons. Yield is estimated at 1.80 tons per acre. Harvested area is 83 thousand acres.

Alfalfa production is estimated at 36.0 thousand tons. Yield is estimated at 3 tons per acre. Harvested area is 12 thousand acres.

Hay stocks were 75 thousand tons, the lowest since 2019.

Nationally, Corn for grain production in 2024 was estimated at 14.9 billion bushels, down 3 percent from the 2023 estimate. Soybean production in 2024 totaled 4.37 billion bushels, up 5 percent from 2023.
