According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 9, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 6 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 6 percent short, 82 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus.
