Milk production in **New York** during April 2024 totaled 1.34 billion pounds, unchanged from April 2023. The average milk price received by New York farmers in March 2024, at \$22.40 per hundredweight, is \$0.40 higher than February 2024 and \$0.30 higher than March a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during April 2024 totaled 851 million pounds, down 0.5 percent from April 2023. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in March 2024, at \$21.70 per hundredweight, is \$0.20 lower than February 2024 and \$0.20 lower than March a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during April 2024 totaled 207 million pounds, down 3.7 percent from April 2023. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in March 2024, at \$22.80 per hundredweight, is \$0.40 higher than February 2024 and \$0.60 higher than March a year ago.
