NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

FARGO, N.D. May 13, 2024 - For the week ending May 12, 2024, there were 4.4 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 3% very short, 18% short, 71% adequate, and 8% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 3% very short, 20% short, 70% adequate, and 7% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Soybeans planted was 7%, ahead of 1% last year, but near 9% for the five-year average.

Spring wheat planted was 49%, well ahead of 17% last year, and ahead of 34% average. Emerged was 13%, ahead of 1% last year and 8% average.

Durum wheat planted was 47%, well ahead of 10% last year and 24% average. Emerged was 10%.

Winter wheat condition rated 1% very poor, 1% poor, 33% fair, 60% good, and 5% excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 28%, well ahead of 8% last year, and near 24% average.

Corn planted was 22%, ahead of 4% last year and 15% average. Emerged was 1%, equal to average.

Canola planted was 21%, ahead of 7% last year and 15% average. Emerged was 2%.

Sugarbeet condition rated 0% very poor, 0% poor, 0% fair, 8% good, and 92% excellent. Sugarbeets planted was 92%, well ahead of 43% last year and 51% average.

Oats condition rated 3% very poor, 1% poor, 20% fair, 69% good, and 7% excellent. Oats planted was 37%, well ahead of 10% last year, and ahead of 30% average. Emerged was 12%, ahead of 1% last year and 6% average.

Barley planted was 37%, well ahead of 11% last year, and ahead of 30% average. Emerged was 9%, ahead of 2% last year, and near 6% average.

Dry edible peas planted was 48%, well ahead of 18% last year, and ahead of 31% average. Emerged was 6%.

Flaxseed planted was 12%, ahead of 5% last year, and near 11% average.

Potatoes planted was 39%. Emerged was 4%.

Dry edible beans planted was 5%.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 1% very poor, 5% poor, 30% fair, 55% good, and 9% excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 2% very short, 15% short, 79% adequate, and 4% surplus.
