NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

FARGO, N.D. July 1, 2024 - For the week ending June 30, 2024, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 2% very short, 5% short, 75% adequate, and 18% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 3% very short, 7% short, 76% adequate, and 14% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Soybean condition rated 2% very poor, 7% poor, 27% fair, 62% good, and 2% excellent. Soybeans emerged was 95%, behind 100% last year, and equal to the five-year average. Blooming was 2%, behind 7% last year, and near 4% average.

Spring wheat condition rated 1% very poor, 2% poor, 19% fair, 64% good, and 14% excellent. Spring wheat jointed was 75%, behind 82% last year, and near 77% average. Headed was 29%, behind 40% last year, and near 32% average.

Durum wheat condition rated 0% very poor, 1% poor, 20% fair, 75% good, and 4% excellent. Durum wheat jointed was 80%, ahead of 63% last year and 69% average. Headed was 35%, ahead of 28% last year and 21% average.

Winter wheat condition rated 1% very poor, 2% poor, 17% fair, 76% good, and 4% excellent. Winter wheat headed was 81%, near 82% last year and 79% average. Coloring was 15%, behind 25% last year, but near 12% average.

Corn condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 23% fair, 66% good, and 4% excellent. Corn silking was 1%, near 2% last year, and equal to average.

Canola condition rated 1% very poor, 5% poor, 27% fair, 64% good, and 3% excellent. Canola emerged was 98%. Blooming was 28%, behind 39% last year, and near 32% average.

Sugarbeet condition rated 1% very poor, 2% poor, 4% fair, 14% good, and 79% excellent.

Oats condition rated 0% very poor, 1% poor, 18% fair, 76% good, and 5% excellent. Oats jointed was 70%, behind 75% last year and 78% average. Headed was 32%, ahead of 27% last year and 25% average.

Barley condition rated 1% very poor, 3% poor, 25% fair, 62% good, and 9% excellent. Barley jointed was 80%, near 78% last year and 79% average. Headed was 30%, behind 36% last year, and near 33% average.

Dry edible peas condition rated 0% very poor, 1% poor, 15% fair, 78% good, and 6% excellent. Dry edible peas blooming was 25%, well behind 51% last year, and behind 37% average.

Sunflower condition rated 0% very poor, 1% poor, 24% fair, 74% good, and 1% excellent. Sunflowers emerged was 89%, near 90% last year and 85% average.

Flaxseed condition rated 0% very poor, 1% poor, 17% fair, 78% good, and 4% excellent. Flaxseed emerged was 92%. Blooming was 4%, behind 13% both last year and average.

Potato condition rated 1% very poor, 7% poor, 35% fair, 52% good, and 5% excellent. Potatoes emerged was 95%, near 91% last year, and equal to average. Blooming was 25%, ahead of 12% last year and 9% average. Rows closed was 9%.

Dry edible bean condition rated 1% very poor, 6% poor, 32% fair, 58% good, and 3% excellent. Dry edible beans emerged was 95%, equal to both last year and average.

Alfalfa condition rated 1% very poor, 8% poor, 12% fair, 66% good, and 13% excellent. Alfalfa first cutting was 49%, behind 64% last year, and near 53% average. Second cutting was 1%.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 1% very poor, 8% poor, 15% fair, 60% good, and 16% excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 3% very short, 7% short, 81% adequate, and 9% surplus.
