## NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**FARGO, N.D. November 12, 2024** - For the week ending November 10, 2024, there were 5.3 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 21% very short, 34% short, 43% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 20% very short, 35% short, 43% adequate, and 2% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 2% very poor, 27% poor, 23% fair, 41% good, and 7% excellent. Winter wheat emerged was 95%, near 96% for both last year and the five-year average.

Corn harvested was 90%, ahead of 73% last year and 72% average.

Sunflowers harvested was 76%, well ahead of 56% last year, and ahead of 67% average.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 18% very poor, 25% poor, 32% fair, 24% good, and 1% excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 20% very short, 21% short, 56% adequate, and 3% surplus.
