NORTH DAKOTA DECEMBER 1, 2024 GRAIN AND HAY STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. January 10, 2025 - All wheat stored in all positions in North Dakota on December 1, 2024 totaled 243 million bushels, up 12% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 173 million bushels are up 24% from 2023 and off-farm stocks of 69.8 million bushels are down 11% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 30.3 million bushels, up 70% from a year ago.

Barley totaled 30.5 million bushels. Of the total 15.5 million bushels are stored on farms, down 46% from 2023. Off-farm stocks, at 15 million bushels, are up 3% from last year.

Corn stocks totaled 475 million bushels, up 12% from 2023. Of the total, 325 million bushels are stored on farms, up 14% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 150 million bushels, are up 9% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 132 million bushels, up 13% from last year. On-farm stocks of 79.0 million bushels are up 36% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 53.0 million bushels, are down 9% from 2023.

Oats stocks on farm, at 2.80 million bushels, are down 32% from a year ago.

Hay stocks on North Dakota farms totaled 3.55 million tons on December 1, 2024, down 16% from a year earlier.

Grain storage capacity in North Dakota totaled 1.39 billion bushels, unchanged from December 1, 2023. Total grain storage capacity is comprised of 930 million bushels of on-farm storage, unchanged from last year, and 460 million bushels of off-farm storage, unchanged from 2023.
