## NORTH DAKOTA POTATO SUMMARY

**FARGO, N.D. September 26, 2024** - Final production for the 2023 **potato** crop totaled 26.4 million cwt, up 21% from 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Planted acres for 2023 totaled 76,000, up 3% from 2022. Harvested area, at 75,500 acres, was up 4% from the previous year. Yield for all potatoes averaged 350 cwt in 2023, 50 cwt per acre higher than the 2022 average yield.

The value of potatoes sold from the 2023 crop totaled \$376 million, up 43% from 2022. The marketing year average price was \$15.30 per cwt, up from \$12.90 for the 2022 crop.

Potatoes sold from the 2023 crop totaled 24.6 million cwt, up 20% from 2022. Sales accounted for 93% of production, down 1% from the 2022 crop.
