NORTH DAKOTA FARM NUMBERS UNCHANGED

FARGO, N.D. February 18, 2022 - North Dakota's number of farms and ranches remained unchanged during 2021, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms and ranches in the state, at 26,000, was unchanged from 2020. Numbers of farms and ranches in North Dakota with less than \$100,000 in agricultural sales decreased 100 farms from a year earlier while operations with agricultural sales of \$100,000 or more increased 100 farms.

Land in farms and ranches in North Dakota totaled 39.3 million acres, unchanged from 2020. The average size of operation, at 1,512 acres, was unchanged from a year earlier.
